



## Crossroads Together – Carer Links Service Covid 19 Statement

The Crossroads Together team would like to take this opportunity to clarify some changes and update you with some recent developments on how we are currently supporting carers. Our CarerLinks service is still delivering support during the Covid-19 pandemic. All offices are closed but the Carer Advisors are working remotely in all locations, this is so we are working within the Government guidelines.

Who are Crossroad Together	Crossroads Together support unpaid carers by offering a number of services across Cheshire West, Greater Manchester, Liverpool, and Herefordshire. These services include information and advice, social groups for carers, end of life care, support for parent carers and young carer services.
How CarerLinks can help at this time:	<ul> <li>The team are accepting and welcoming new referrals</li> <li>By supporting carers to think about their own needs and plan action for change. (This is being done by phone and email)</li> <li>The advisors are still working with the assessments tool the Outcome Star</li> <li>By listening and offering a range of services and support to help carers improve their health and wellbeing, including, information, advice, advocacy and signposting</li> <li>By working in partnership to link carers with all other sources of help and support.</li> <li>By helping with applications for Attendance Allowance, Carers Allowance, PIP and Blue Badges.</li> <li>By operating an information and support line for carers 9am-5pm Monday to Friday.</li> </ul>

Carer Support Line	The Carers Support Line opens Monday – Friday 9am—5pm and is manned by a designated Carer Advisor who is available to speak with Carers and other organisations and partners to answer queries and offer advice and support.  We are available to provide a listening ear and support when carers are feeling overwhelmed or finding it hard to cope. We understand the isolation and stress they may be experiencing.
Carer Emergency Card	The credit card sized card, issued by Crossroads Together, can be carried by carers and highlights that they look after someone who needs care. It contains details of whom they want to be contacted in an emergency. The card can be obtained by ringing the Carers Support Service. (Details further down)
